

Terms and conditions: Proposals must be submitted in the prescribed "Proposal Outline". Proposals may be submitted in writing, via email or US mail. Speakers are required to pay transportation expenses, and provide their own computers. LCD projectors will be furnished by the conference. Priority will be given to speakers and/or panels with grassroots neighborhood leadership. Workshops will be held on Friday, September 18 and/or Saturday, September 19. The review committee reserves the right to merge workshops and panels as deemed appropriate. Upon approval, a speaker commitment agreement will be sent to all speakers.

Proposal Outline

Please respond on letter-sized (8 1/2 x 11) paper or via email, using the following outline:

I. Workshop Information:

- A. *Title* suggested workshop title for registration booklet (based on topic list)
- B. **Description** for registration booklet, 60 word maximum
- C. *Extended Description* include three learning objectives for review committee discernment, 300 words maximum
- D. **Speaker bio** --50 word maximum
- E. **Neighborhood Participation** describe how the workshop will involve and potentially impact the grassroots neighborhood attendees
- F. **Session Format** (e.g. panel, moderated session, debate, clinic, lecture, etc.)
- G. Audio/Visual equipment please list equipment to be used. LCD projectors to be provided by conference
